## POOL GUEST RULES

### Local Guests

- Monday through Friday \$3.00 per person
- Saturday, Sunday or Holidays \$4.00 per person
- Members must sign YCC ticket - No Cash
- Persons may not be a guest more than once a week Mon -Sun.
- Only 3 in-town guests at a time unless prior arrangements have been made with club management. An additional \$10.00 fee will be assessed along with the \$3.00/\$4.00 per guest fee when in-town guests exceed 3 people (birthday parties, sports teams, etc.)
- Please remember all parties must be scheduled through the Clubhouse office to avoid conflicts.

### Out-of-Town Guests

- Houseguests of a resident member may be guests daily.
- Guests must have a pass from the Clubhouse office. The charge is \$2.00 per person/day.
- Members' unmarried children under 26 years of age and who are currently attending college may enjoy the swimming privileges of the club.
- Members may bring their grandchildren and will not be charged a guest fee.
- All grandchildren must be accompanied by the member/grandparent.

# SWIM LESSONS

The swim lesson sign-ups will begin Saturday May 28th through the pool office. Please call the front office after this date and ask for the pool to sign up for lessons. The Clubhouse Office will not be able to do sign-ups for lessons. Please speak to a lifeguard after the opening of the pool to help you with questions regarding swim lessons and to sign up for the summer. Lessons start at the age of 4 years through 12+ years depending on the child's ability level. We look forward to all of the returning swimmers and new ones to join us in the mornings for fun learning in and around the water.

## LESSON SCHEDULE\*

Sessions run Mon - Thurs for a two week session, totaling 8 classes per session

Session cost is \$50.00 per child.

There are 2 scheduled class times:

10:00 am - 10:40 am and 10:45 am - 11:25 am.

Classes run for 40 minutes. Level 1 class will run 30 to 40 minutes depending on ability.

Session 2	June 27th-June 30th July 5th- July 7th **
Session 3	July 11th- July 14th July 18th- July 21st
Session 4	July 25th- July 28th Aug 1st - Aug 4th
Session 5	Aug 8th - Aug 11th Aug 15th - Aug 18th

## A few things to remember when visiting the YCC Pool:

Ask about new safety and pool rules for the 2011 season.

**Please remember that all parties; birthday, school, sports, etc. are to be scheduled through the Clubhouse office.**

- Stop at the check-in table and sign in by member name and number.
- All guests must be accompanied by a member and must be signed in, including grandchildren.
- All children under the age of 11 must be accompanied by an adult or young adult 16 years of age or over.
- The use of the diving board will be up to the discretion of the head lifeguard on duty or club/pool management.
- Non-swimmers are not allowed in the deep end of the pool unless they are directly supervised by an adult. **This includes non-swimmers wearing lifejackets.**
