## POOL GUEST RULES

### LOCAL GUESTS:

- Monday through Friday \$3 per person.
- Saturday, Sunday or holidays \$4 per person.
- Members must sign YCC ticket – no cash.
- **Persons may not be a guest more than once a week.**
- Only 3 in-town guests at a time unless prior arrangements have been made with club management. An additional \$10 fee will be assessed along with the \$3 per guest fee when in-town guests exceed 3 people (birthday parties, sports teams, etc.).
- Please remember that **all parties must be scheduled through the clubhouse office to avoid conflicts.**

### OUT-OF-TOWN GUESTS:

- Houseguests of a resident member may be guests daily.
- They must have a guest pass from the clubhouse office, and the charge is \$2 per person per day.
- Members' unmarried children under 26 years of age and who are attending college may enjoy the swimming privileges of the club.
- Members may bring their grandchildren and will not be charged a guest fee.
- **All grandchildren must be accompanied by the member/grandparent.**

\*\*All pool hours and snack stand hours are weather permitting and subject to change due to maintenance and pool/club events. Pool maintenance will be performed between 7 am and 10 am.

# SWIM LESSONS

The swim lesson sign-ups will begin May 29 through the pool office. Please call the front office after this date and ask for the pool to sign up for lessons. The clubhouse office will not be able to do sign-ups for lessons. Please speak to a lifeguard after the opening of the pool to help you with questions regarding swim lessons and to sign-up for the summer. Cost is \$50 per child per session. Lessons will run in two-week sessions and the classes will run Monday through Thursday for a total of 8 classes. Lessons start at the age of 4 years - 12 years or so depending on the child's ability level. We look forward to all of the returning swimmers and new ones to join us in the mornings for fun learning in and around the water.

## LESSON SCHEDULE

All swim lessons are weather permitting and subject to change due to maintenance and pool/club events.

### CLASS TIMES:

*Session 1:* June 14 thru June 17  
June 21 thru June 24

*Session 2:* June 28 thru July 1  
July 5 thru July 8

*Session 3:* July 12 thru July 15  
July 19 thru July 22

*Session 4:* July 26 thru July 29  
August 2 thru August 5

*Session 5:\** August 9 thru August 12

\*Session 5 will be limited to one week of instruction, and number of classes and times will be limited.



### A few things to remember when visiting the YCC pool:

- Please throw all trash away immediately due to yellowjackets in the summer.
- Stop at the check-in table and sign in by member name and number.
- All guests must be accompanied by a member and must be signed in, including grandchildren.
- All children under the age of 11 must be accompanied by an adult or young adult 16 years of age or over.
- The use of the diving board will be up to the discretion of the head lifeguard on duty or club/pool management.
- Non-swimmers are not allowed in the deep end of the pool unless they are directly supervised by an adult. **This includes non-swimmers wearing lifejackets.**
- **WATER-WINGS ARE NOT ALLOWED OFF THE DIVING BOARD.**
