## Grounds Report

The one necessary annual aggressive aerification on the greens is completed. We do this mid-August to insure good weather and shorten the healing process. It also tends to be the period of our golf season that allows the most time between tournaments. September is always a busy month with several tournaments, including the member-member.

We will be working on replacing as many asphalt paths on the front nine as possible this fall.

Doing as much as the weather allows and staying within the funds available is our goal. I expect we will come close to completing all the front nine cart paths.

Along with other maintenance we will be aerifying fairways as we utilize openings that are available to complete another important cultural practice. Some fairways we will pull a core and over-

seed them with ryegrass, while other fairways a solid tine with no core will be used. Neither process causes much disruption when the grass is growing aggressively, which is again the reason for

choosing to do it at this time of year.

Enjoy the great September weather we usually experience with some rounds of golf!

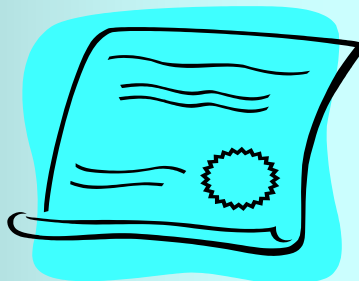
